

BACKGROUND CHECK

Newton Area Flag Football League, hereafter the NAFFL, requires the following:

In order for an individual to be eligible to participate in NAFFL as a coach, that individual may be required to undergo a Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check and/or a Sex Offender Registry Information (SORI) check. Individuals found to have certain criminal convictions or pending criminal actions will be presumed ineligible to participate in such activities. NAFFL is authorized by the Commonwealth's Department of Criminal Justice Information Services, pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 6, Sections 167-178B, to access CORI records. Sex Offender checks shall be performed pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 6, Sections 178C-178P.

The NAFFL interests are to ensure the highest safety for the children that participate. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.

By completing the online consent form, coaches certify that I have read the Background Check policy and attest that they DO NOT have any criminal convictions or pending criminal actions that would preclude their participation in any and all NAFFL activities. Any individuals that are uncertain about their eligibility should contact NAFFL representatives by email at admin@newtonareafgfootball.com and a full CORI / SORI report will be provided at no cost to the prospective coach.

Further, by completing the online consent form, coaches certify they will abide by the NAFFL policies outlined in this document and are required to update NAFFL staff in the event of any change in their CORI / SORI status. In the event that I am found to have violated any of the policies, I understand I will no longer be permitted to coach in the NAFFL and may face other potential disciplinary actions according to local, state, and national laws.
